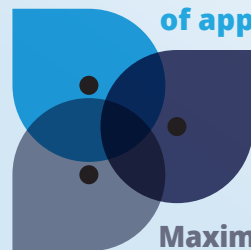

SmartPICO is an advanced laser system by Lynton that features a combination of 4 different emissions and is one of the most flexible devices on the market. It can treat a range of concerns including dyschromia, pigmented lesions, melasma and post-inflammatory hyperpigmentation, with minimal contraindications.



Who's this treatment for?

SmartPICO can be used on all skin types displaying the signs of ageing. It is also suitable for scars caused by acne and trauma.

Is the treatment uncomfortable?

SmartPICO treatments are well-tolerated by most patients. Only a mild tingling sensation and painless heat can be felt.

What do I have to do beforehand?

Avoid sun exposure and tanning beds/lamps for at least one month prior to treatment. The skin has to be clean and free of cosmetics. Additionally, medication that could also alter light sensitivity must be avoided.

How many treatments are needed?

Results can be seen from the first session. Procedures can be repeated once a month, on average, offering progressive results and very short recovery times.

What do I have to do afterwards?

The treatment area might be red and, on rare occasions, mild bleeding can occur. Depending on the reaction of a patient, a practitioner will apply a suitable bandage and issue further care instructions. Any redness tends to fade within 4-7 days.

What effects can I expect?

From the first session, the skin will appear more polished, toned and smooth, and pores will be visibly tighter after a few days. Improvements will be progressive and continuous until they become permanent and long-lasting within four months of starting treatment.
